### Winner Karma Kids Yoga



The most popular class is the parent-and-child session, where moms or dads can try fun, animal-inspired poses with kids from walking age to three. Two-year-old Sophie Whelan's mom, Heather, swears by the benefits of Karma's downward dog: "She does it all at home, so I know she's learning." 
